Join us for a springtime excursion to two great museums near Gettysburg, Pa. Drive your Hudson, Essex or Terraplane!

We'll start at 10 AM at the Beyond The Battle Museum, Gettysburg, PA. Recently awarded USA Today's Reader's Choice "Best New Museum" rating, its remarkable exhibits, artifacts and eyewitness accounts tell the extraordinary stories of ordinary residents during and after the battle. The immersive "Caught in the Crossfire" exhibit is thrilling. Reserved "Hudson" parking is at the right end of the building. General admission is \$15 + tax (seniors \$1 less). Around noon, we'll caravan the five minutes to Hoss's Steak & Sea House. Guests will order and pay for their own meals, enjoyed in a private dining room. Afterwards we'll drive north on US Route 15, to the Eastern



SCHEDULE

10 AM: Meet at the **Beyond the Battle Museum**, 625 Biglerville Rd., Gettysburg, PA. 17325 (home of Adams County Historical Museum). Each person pays own admission. Hudson parking area is at right end of building as viewed from the road.

Around noon: Lunch at **Hoss's Steak & Sea House**, 1140 York Rd., Gettysburg, 17325. Each participant orders and pays for his/her own lunch.

Around 2 PM: Caravan to **Eastern Museum of Motor Racing**, 100 Baltimore Rd., York Springs, Pa. 17372. From Hoss's, go east on U.S. 30 then north on Rte. 15. Drive 14.2 miles to Latimore Valley Rd. Turn right. (See map for further details.)

If you're planning to attend, please let us know by **April 29**; with enough attendees, we may be able to get discounted tickets for the Beyond the Battle Museum. Event is "rain or shine".
